Transformation: Requests for Proposals

Secure Commitment Transitional Housing

- JPD released an informal solicitation to identify a transitional housing provider to respond to immediate reentry needs for our Secure Youth Treatment Facility population. The contract will be presented to the Commission for approval in October.
- JPD will be convening a Reentry Work Group for the DJJ Realignment Subcommittee to inform reentry planning for youth released from secure commitment to address all aspects of reentry, including housing. JPD intends to pursue a formal Request for Qualifications for transitional housing services this fiscal year.

Transformation: Requests for Proposals

Multisystemic Therapy (MST)

- JPD released an RFP on 9/8/23 to support the development and implementation of one MST team to exclusively serve youth under the jurisdiction of the San Francisco Juvenile Delinquency Court.  - **Proposal are due 10/2/23 by 3 PM.**
- The Families First Prevention Services Act (FFPSA) created this opportunity to expand the skills and capacity of San Francisco community based mental health providers to deliver this nationally recognized evidence-based therapeutic practice.

Transformation: CARC Expansion

- JPD is working with DCYF to increase funding to the Community Assessment and Referral Center (CARC).
- Additional funding will support a Case Manager and Program Coordinator.
- These positions will enable CARC to accept felony citation referrals for arrests that occur outside of CARC business hours.
- **With this expansion, all young people who are cited for misdemeanors and felonies in San Francisco will be connected to CARC.**

Transformation:

DCYF 2024-2029 RFP

DCYF has issued the Request for Proposals (RFP) for its five-year funding cycle.

- CLARIFICATION: Justice Services grants can serve young people who have been arrested in San Francisco, referred to the San Francisco Juvenile Probation Department, and/or are under the jurisdiction of the San Francisco Juvenile Delinquency Court, including youth who live out of county.
- Important Dates:
 - RFP Proposals Due Friday, October 20, 2023, 5PM
 - RFP Award Decisions Finalized and Announced March 2024

Juvenile Drug Arrests

- **JPD is committed to safely minimizing juvenile detention wherever possible.**
- Increasing safety concerns for youth arrested for drug sales: missed intake appointments, missed court appearances, repeat offending; unsafe living situations; vulnerable groups; youth experiencing withdrawal symptoms from fentanyl use.
- Evolving policy to address safety concerns:
 - Coordinating with justice agencies (DA, Defense, Court) and partners, including IFR/CARC, AFS, JJPA, CURYJ, Alameda County Office of Education
 - No longer citing out youth arrested on drug sales charges **if there is no parent or legal guardian available**
 - Implementing measures minimize length of stay for youth detained on drug sales cases:
 - Culturally & linguistically responsive community support - for youth in the community and in detention
 - Culturally responsive placements
 - Probation field visits.
