

#### **GUN VIOLENCE – UP 10% compared to 2022**


- There were 2 shooting incidents causing injuries to 2 victims this week.

- There was 1 homicide incident for the week ending 09.03.23
  - o There are 38 homicides YTD with 25 incidents resulting from a firearm.
  - Overall Clearance Rate: 78%





