# What prompted the amendment?

Internal review of currently posted DGO 5.01 led to questions relating to compliance when using TDDs.

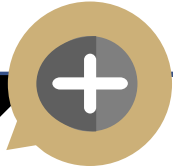
**Expedited Amendment (3.01.04(H) )**

COP decided to amend. Approval by Pres Elias. DPA worked closely with SFPD. Commissioner Benedicto reviewed. 30-day dev timeline (July 14-August 25)

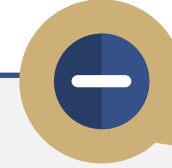

# Positives w/ TDDs v. Negatives w/o TDDs



- De-escalation tool consistent with law and policy mandates
- Save lives by preventing and ending pursuits
- Enable apprehensions without pursuits
- Reduces vehicle performance to lower speed
- Provide officers with time and distance
- Officers already trained on deployment
- Technology Pillar of 21<sup>st</sup> Century Policing



- Requires escalation to pursuit before deployment
- High priority crime suspects are not pursuable within policy
- Mere attempts to stop can result in dangerous evasion even without pursuit
- Limits opportunities for arrest and raises danger level to public

# TDD Data Over 15-Month Period

March, 2022 through May, 2023

# Policy Changes

- Revisions begin on p. 16, Section 5.01.08, F
- Developed jointly by SFPD and DPA policy teams
- Authorized circumstances are clarified and narrowly tailored
- Remains a reportable use of force
- Adds procedure to report property damage
- Use during pursuits remains under DGO 5.05

## Next Steps

- Meet and Confer
- DGO adoption & implementation after conclusion of meet and confer
- Re-establish use of TDD outside of pursuits
- Continue to be included in SFPD Quarterly Activity & Data Reports (vehicle interventions)
- Request through the Chief to initiate (3.01.04(A)(4)(a)) update of DGO 5.05 regarding TDDs & rescind outdated Bureau Order
