A LOOK AT THE TARAVAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

The second phase of the project is Segment B along the L Taraval line from Sunset Blvd. to 15th Ave., and on Ulloa St. near West Portal. The work is expected to last until the fall of 2024. Once completed, the corridor will boast new transit priority traffic signals, bulb-outs, high visibility crosswalks, safety boarding islands and increased accessibility which will make pedestrian crossing safer.

All of these upgrades will make Taraval St. a more inviting and attractive choice for visitors and San Franciscans to access shops, restaurants and services.
