

### JH Chart 4: Admissions by Primary Reason




Average Daily Population & Peak Population by Month




# JH Charts 3.2: Average Length of Stay for Youth Released

# PS Chart 1: Probation Referrals, CARC Intakes, & MIR Referrals





#### • CLARIFICATIONS:

- Justice Services grants can serve young people who have been arrested in San Francisco, referred to the San Francisco Juvenile Probation Department, and/or are under the jurisdiction of the San Francisco Juvenile Delinquency Court, including youth who live out of county.
- The Justice Services Care Coordinator Strategy can serve youth ages 12-25.

## Use of Confiscated Funds

Transformation

#### Confiscated Funds

- Identified \$63,000 in confiscated funds from prior years.
- Identified the names and addresses of 600 youth, owed \$12,739.
  - After two mailings and disbursements, \$10,231 remain.
- In June of 2021, JPD implemented a new process for collecting funds from youth admitted to Juvenile Hall. All funds confiscated have been returned to youth released from the Hall.
- In total, \$43,173 remains that could be used for other purposes by Commission.
  - Recommendation to use for direct emergency payments for young people and their families, such as funerals and emergency housing.
