

#### **GUN VIOLENCE – DOWN 2% compared to 2022**


- There were 2 shooting incidents causing injuries to 2 victim this week.

- There were NO homicide incidents for the week ending 10.01.23
  - o There are 40 homicides YTD with 27 incidents resulting from a firearm.
  - Overall Clearance Rate: 75%





