## DGO 5.05, Emergency Vehicle Response

### STATUS OF CURRENT POLICY

- Last updated on 5/22/2013 and includes all tenets of the law.
- When changes to laws are made, POST updates learning domains which are taught at the Academy
- Currently, the policy is not in the annual Commission-approved revision plan.
- Any major law changes could be updated with a Department Notice as needed

### WHAT DOES THE POLICY ALLOW:

- When a pursuit can and cannot be initiated
- Intervention Tactics, Roadblocks
- Role of the supervisor
- Responsibilities following a pursuit officer vs. supervisor
- Reporting requirements
- Command level notification
- Annual training

## Driver Training

Driver training program highlights are:

- **Learning Domain 19:** Basic Academy training
- **Annual Recertification:** Station/ Unit Training coordinators
- **Advanced Officer/ Continued Professional Training:** Biennial EVOG Perishable Skills Program

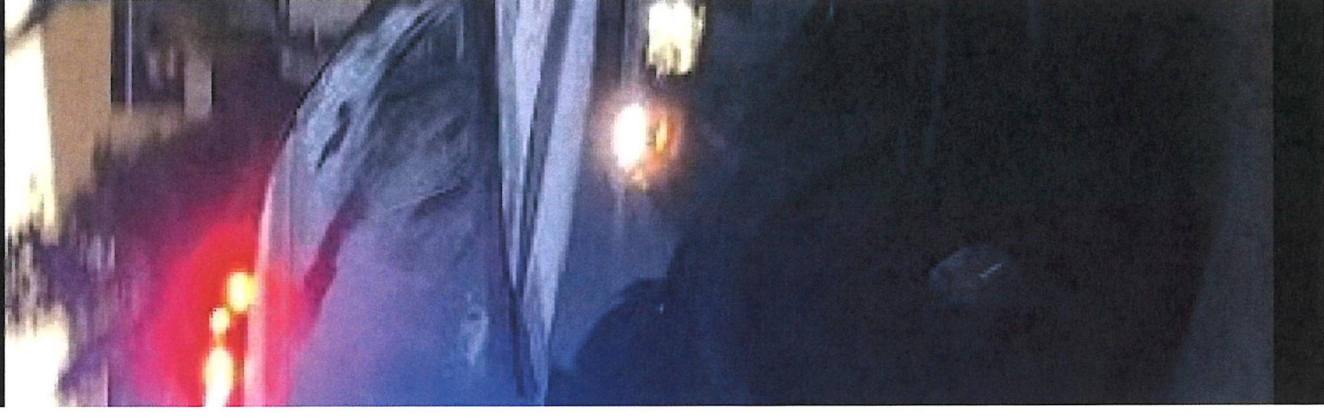

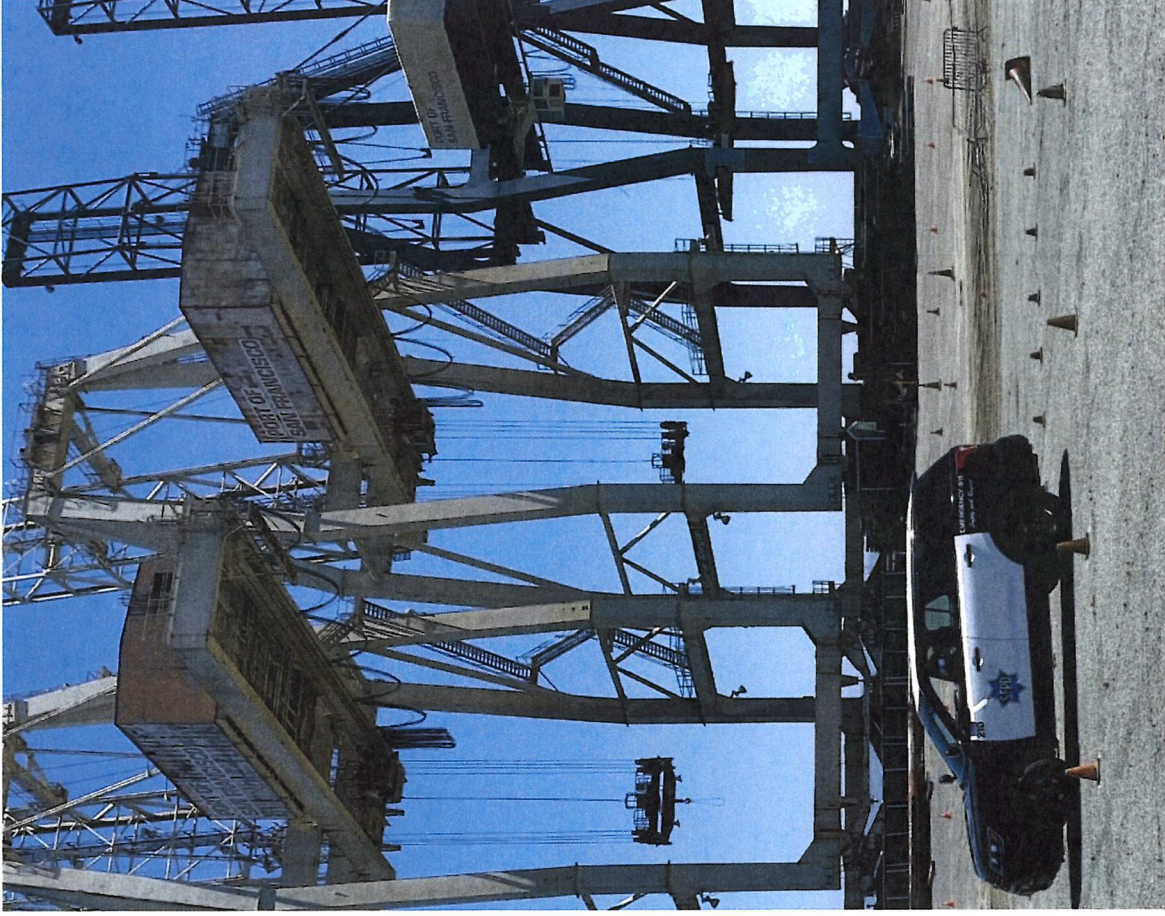
### Annual Recertification

# Advanced Officer/Continued Professional Training



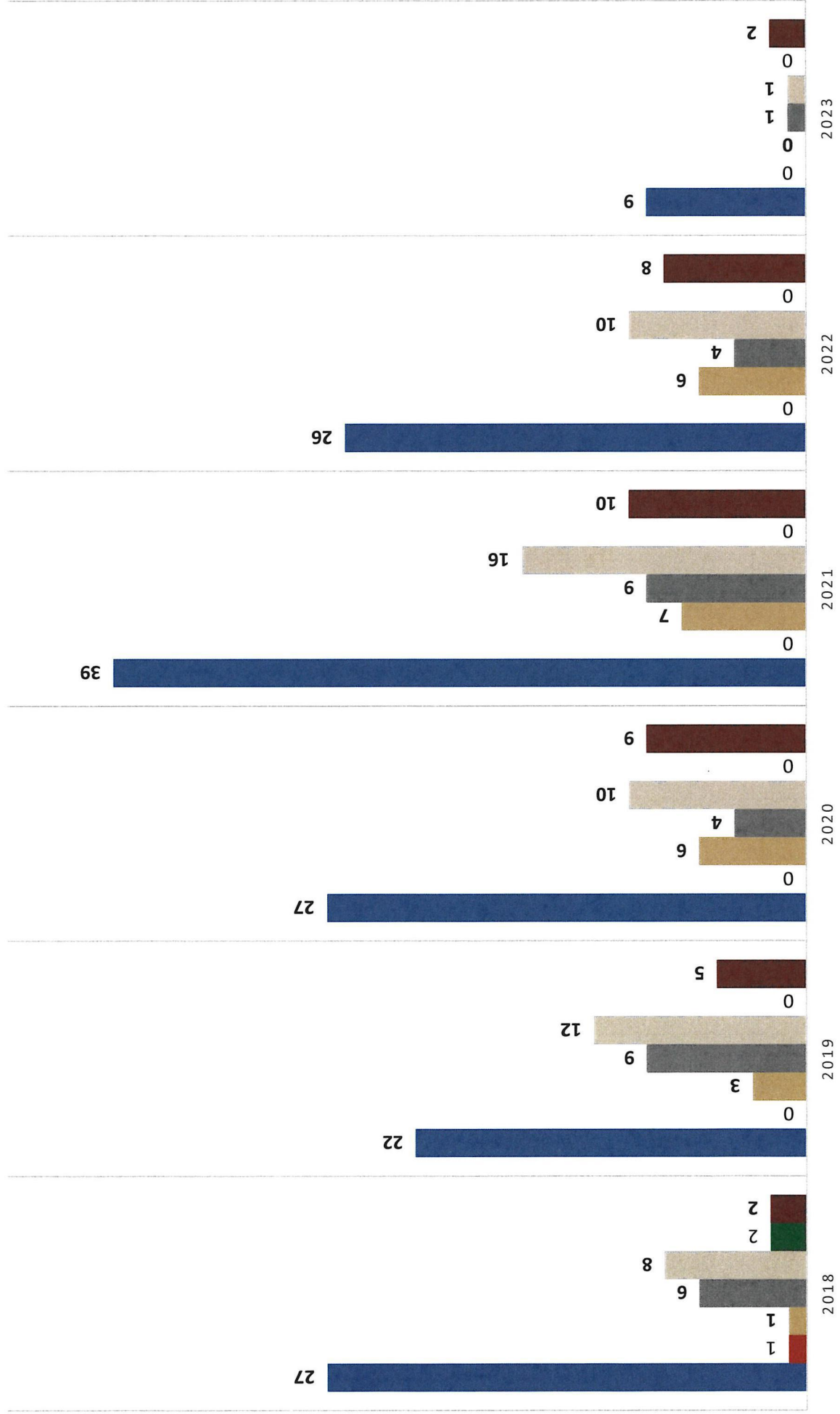
## EVOC PSP
