I sew the shirts myself with locally sourced fabric purchased second-hand. My friends and I curate the phrases, they usually come to mind as we perceive our cats.

From a pattern, I cut out the shape of the shirts or the catnip pillow pouches. Then I sew them together using a sewing machine. Once they are sewn together for the shirts - I iron on the phrases, for the pouches I stuff them with catnip and close them with a final stitch.
