A - Central	11		Officers used excessive force, pointed a firearm at a person, and made inappropriate comments.
B - Southern	6		An officer exhibited rude behavior when the complainant inquired about the investigation of their missing vehicle. Additionally, the officer failed to investigate the complainant's vehicle theft properly. The officer racially profiled the complainant, pulled him over, and issued a fix-it ticket.
C- Bayview	2		The complainant stated he was arrested, handcuffed, and injured by unknown officers sometime in 2016.
D - Mission	8		Officers failed to investigate and were discourteous. An officer failed to take a harassment report.
E- Northern	7		Officers threatened to tow the complainant's vehicle for expired registration and violated homeless rights. The complainant stated that he was assaulted at Safeway, and the security guard did not do anything. Officers who went to file a police report for him were rude and aggressive with him.
F – Park	6		Officers failed to address the complainant's concerns, failed to generate an incident report, and engaged in inappropriate and biased policing. The officers failed to investigate properly and take the required action.

H - Ingleside	3		Officers failed to take required action concerning multiple missing person reports. Officers engaged in inappropriate behavior/comments. An officer gave out an inaccurate phone number.
I – Taraval	4		Officers were dispatched to the complainant's call regarding the neighbor, but they claimed the address did not exist and did not make contact with the complainant.
J - Tenderloin	5		Officers used excessive force during the arrest of the complainant. The officer instructed medical staff to inject the complainant with Narcan against his will unnecessarily. The officer also used inappropriate language.
