## WHO QUALIFIES ?

- DISABLED VETERANS
- AGES 18-64
- RECEIVES SSDI OR SSI BENEFITS
- UNEMPLOYED
- LOOKING FOR A NEW CAREER

Everyone age 18 through 64 who receives Social Security Disability Insurance (SSDI) and/or Supplemental Security Income (SSI) benefits because of his or her disability is eligible to participate in the Ticket to Work Program. Participation in the Ticket to Work Program is free and voluntary.

The TWP allows you to test your ability to work for at least 9 months. During your TWP, you will receive full SSDI benefits no matter how much you earn as long as your work activity is reported and you have a disabling impairment.
