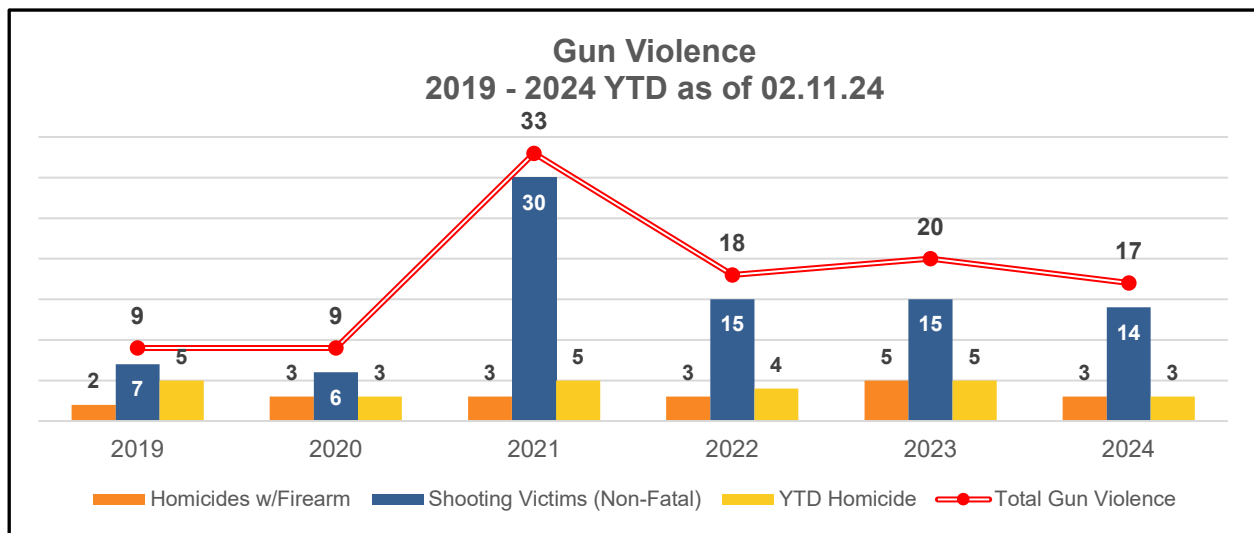

GUN VIOLENCE – DOWN 15% compared to 2023

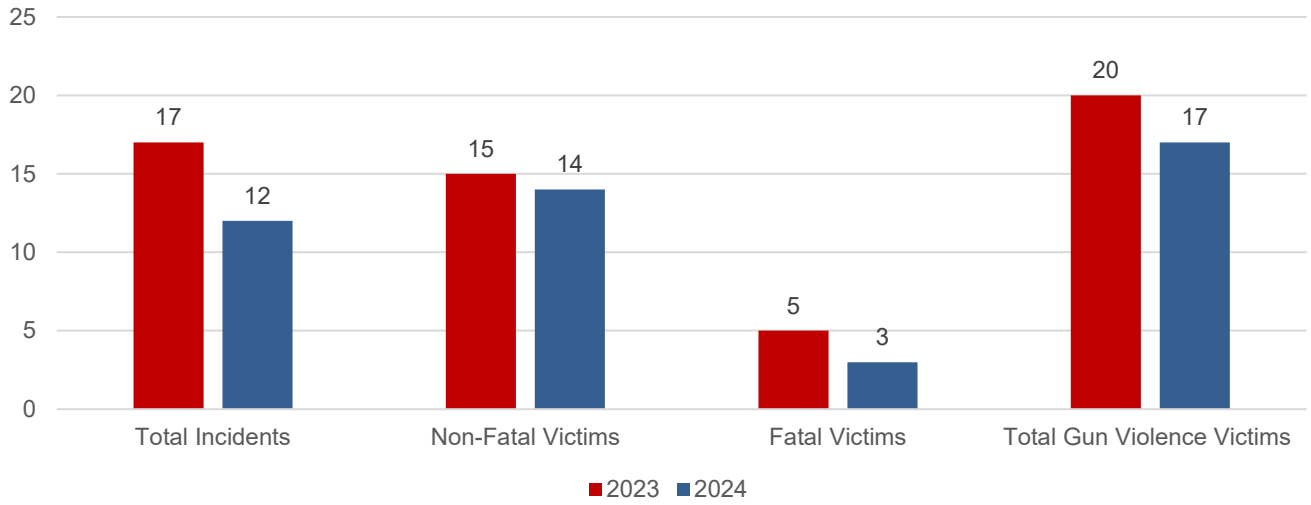
- **There were 2 shooting incidents causing injuries to 2 victims this week.**
 - For the year, there are a total of 17 firearm-related incidents resulting in 17 victims
- **There were 0 homicide incidents for the week ending 02.14.2024**
 - There are 3 homicides YTD with 3 incidents resulting from a firearm.
 - **Overall Clearance Rate: 33%**

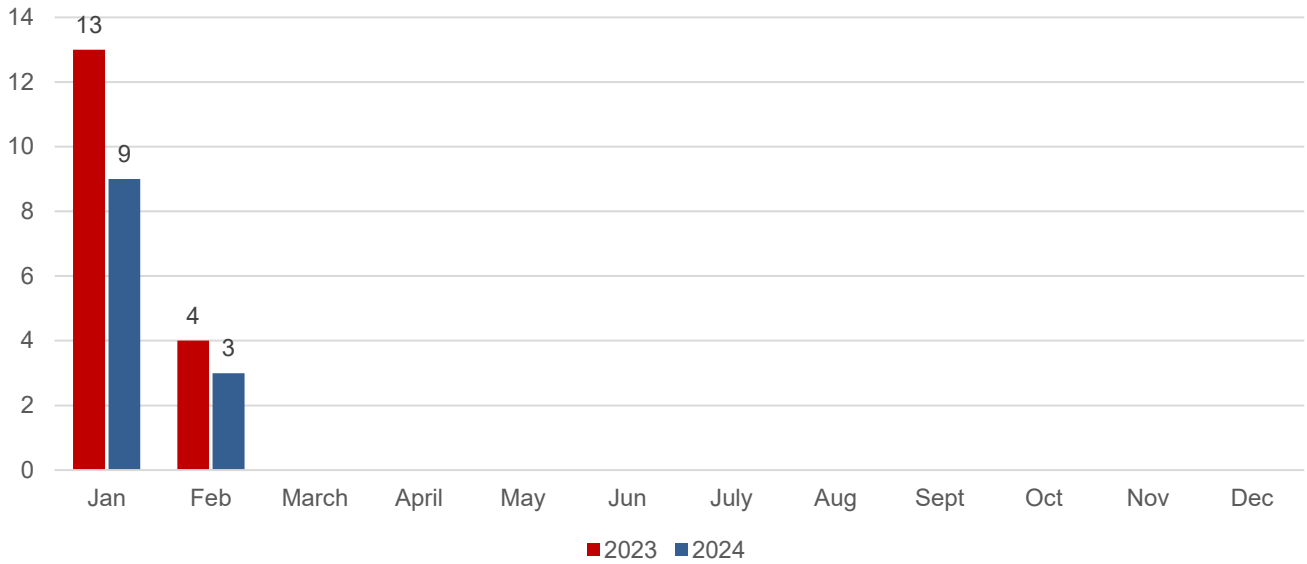

Gun Violence YTD Comparison 2023 vs. 2024

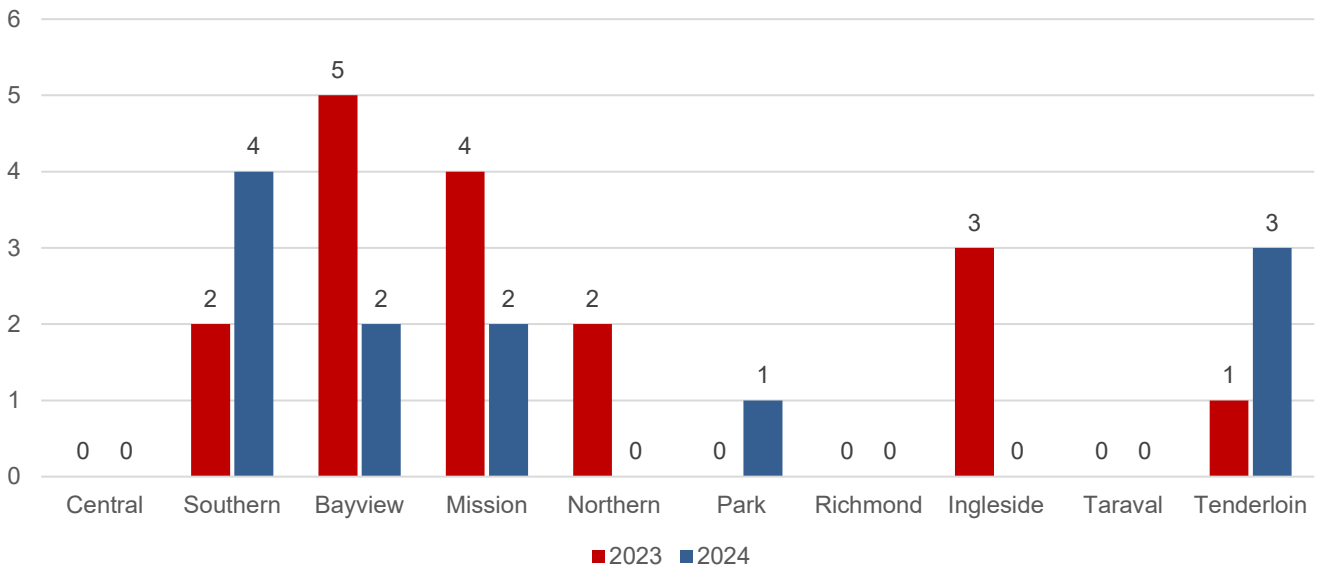

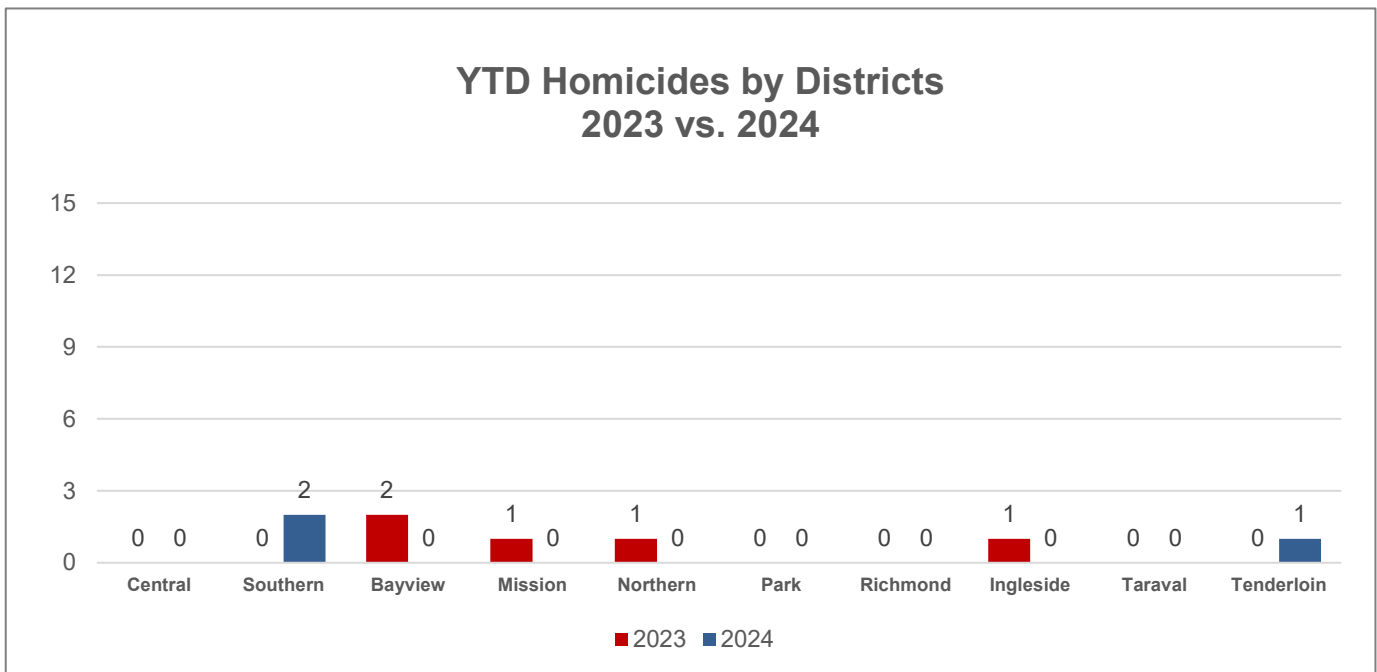
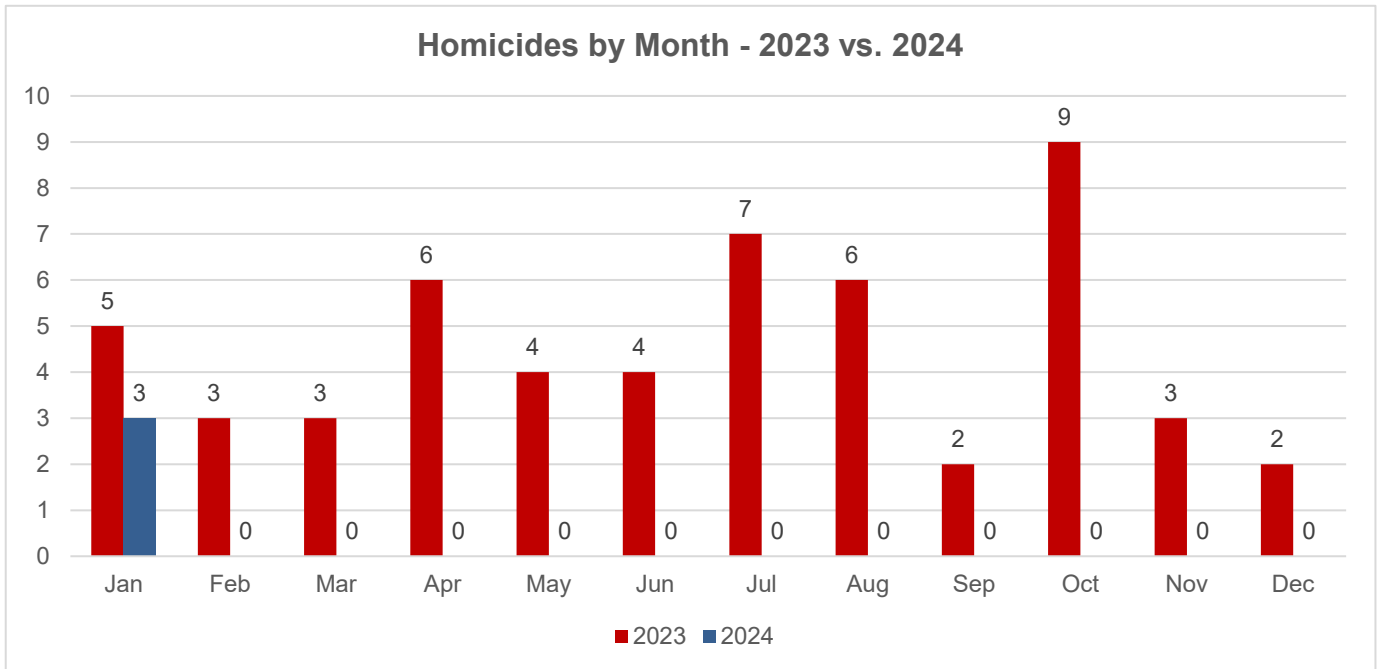
Shootings YTD - By Month - 2023 vs. 2024
