SF ACC placed **186** animals in foster homes during this quarter

Fostered: 140 cats, 23 dogs, 23 others (15 guinea pigs, 7 rabbits, 1 rat). Many of these fostered animals went on to be adopted from us, while many other animals were transferred to our adoption partners

ACOs responded to 2,743 emergency calls for service this quarter

SF ACC received 1 call regarding sightings of outdoor cats this quarter
