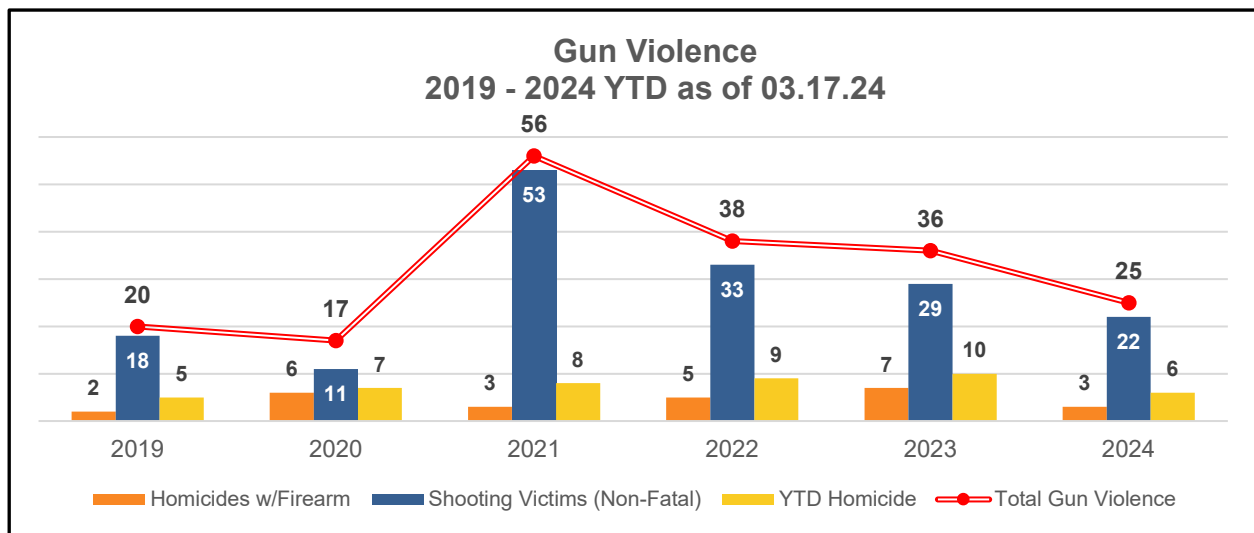

**GUN VIOLENCE – DOWN 40% compared to 2023**

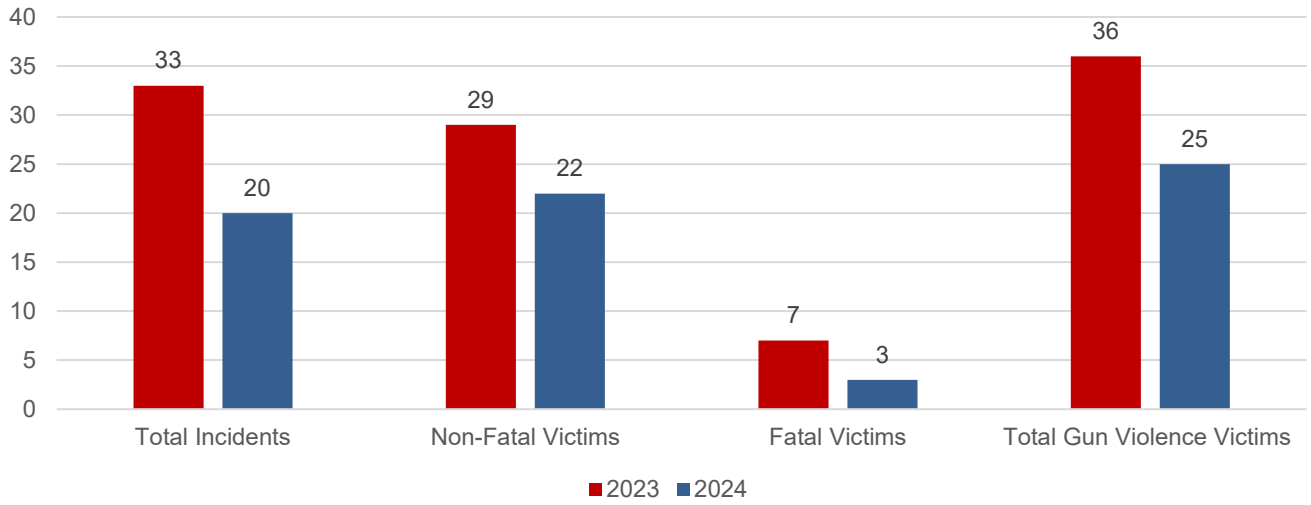
- **There were 3 shooting incidents causing injuries to 3 victims this week.**
  - For the year, there are a total of 20 firearm-related incidents resulting in 25 victims
- **There were 2 homicide incidents for the week ending 03.17.2024f**
  - There are 6 homicides YTD with 3 incidents resulting from a firearm.
  - **Overall Clearance Rate: 83%**

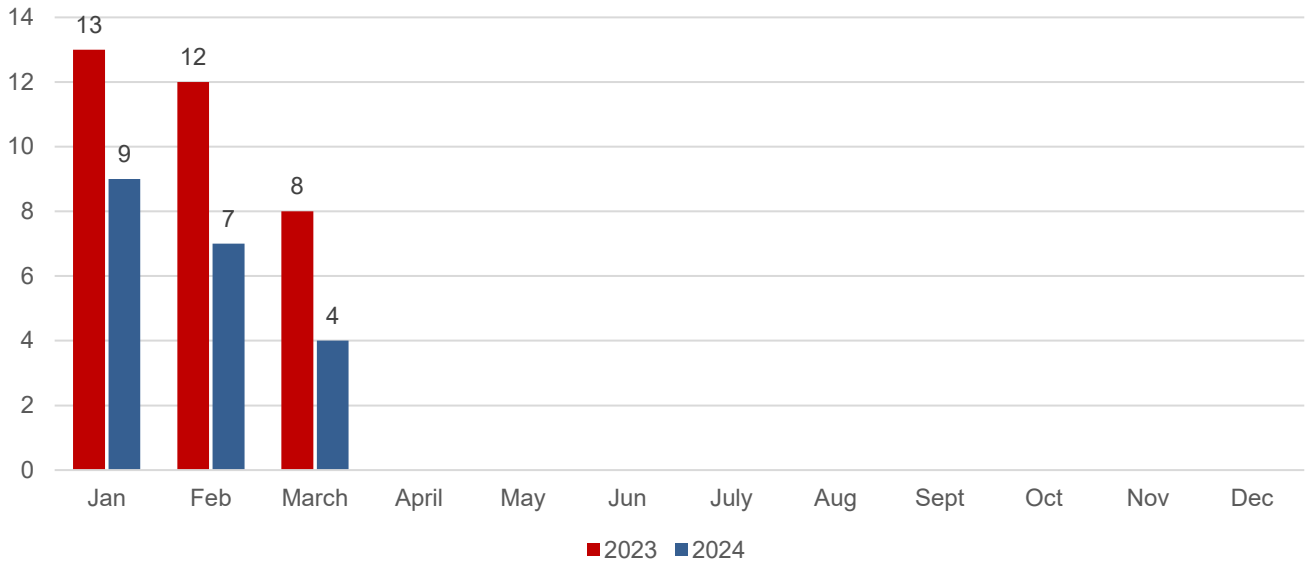

**Gun Violence YTD Comparison 2023 vs. 2024**

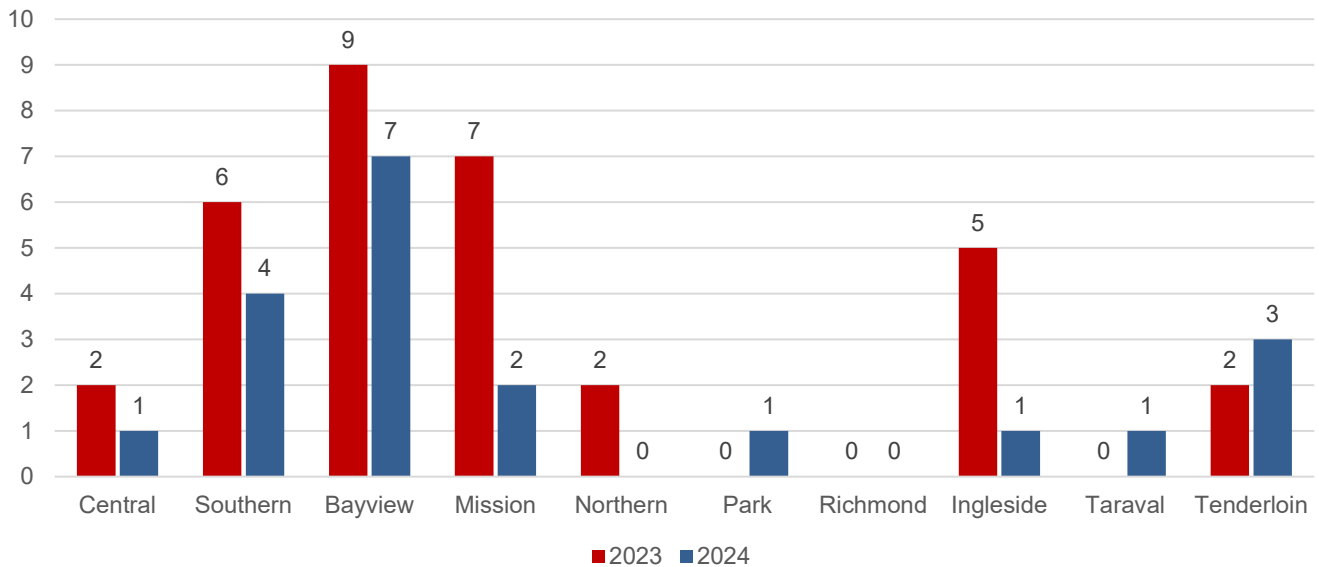

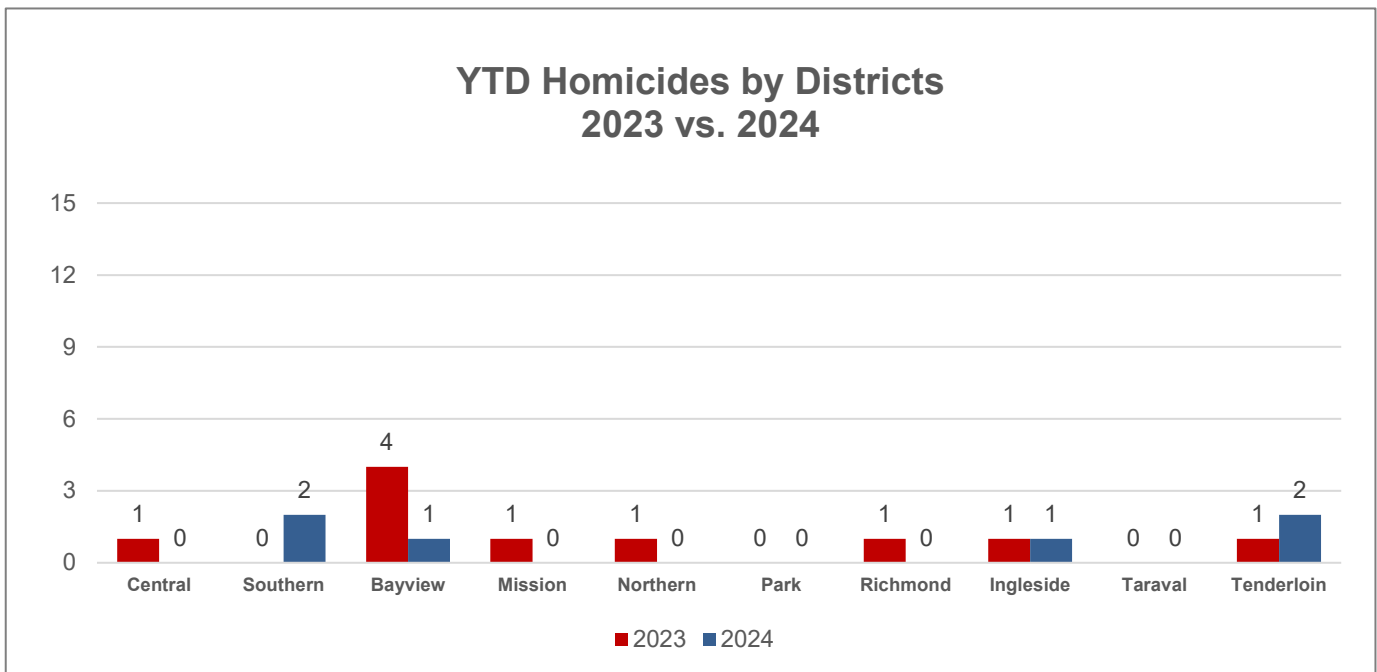
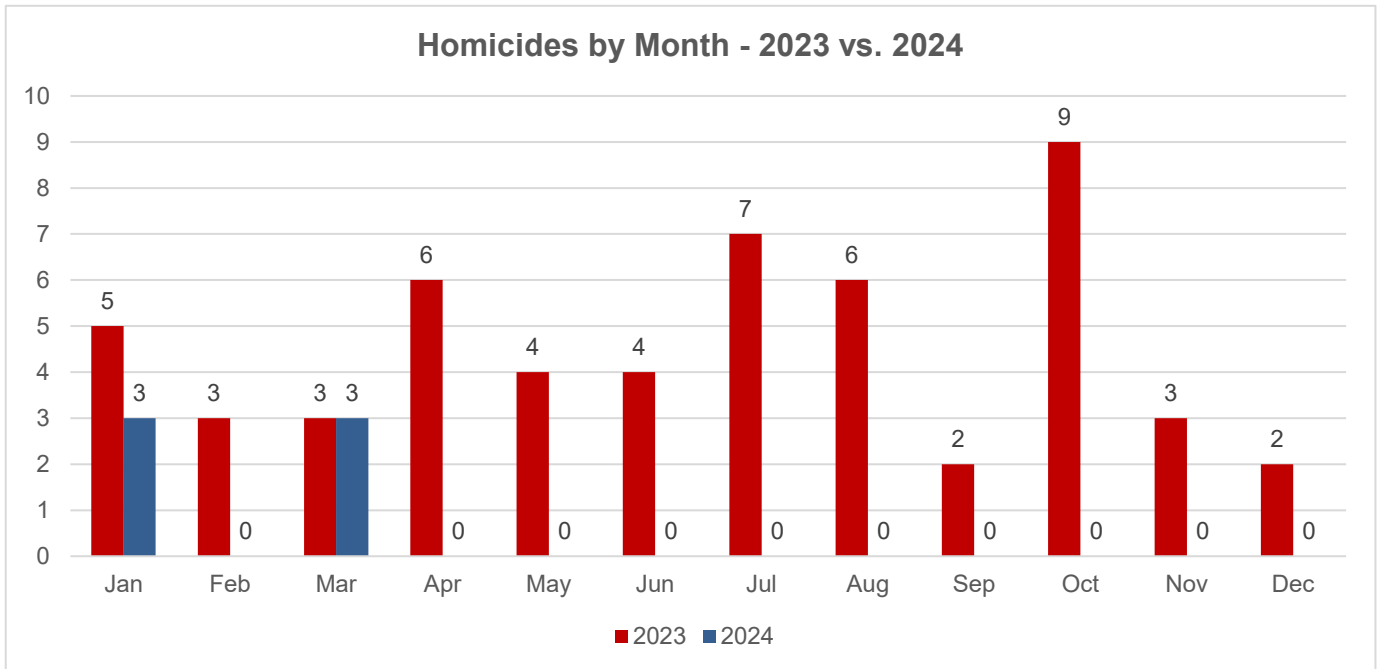
**Shootings YTD - By Month - 2023 vs. 2024**
