- Founded in 2018 in San Francisco under the non-profit Dustys' Fishing Well
- 4-month stipend paid EMT training program
- 2 Cohorts a year
- Also provides wrap-around services like counseling, life coaching, career counseling













### Program Overview

32 hours per week commitment

Training in EMT skills, knowledge, and field experience

Tutoring and mentoring support

Professional development workshops





### Benefits

- \* Training and education through daily classes, tutoring, workshops, and internships.
- \* Training in response, anatomy, and the prevention, treatment, and physiology of various illnesses.
- \* Personal skills enhancement through life coaching, mentorship support, public-speaking opportunities, and practice using leadership skills.
- \* Participate in professional career development workshops.
- \* Receive assistance with career placement upon successful passing of the National EMT Registry.

## Program Successes

- Currently in week 3 of Cohort 7 with 23 students
- 99 total graduates since 2021
- Program stipends have enabled students to stop working at their jobs and concentrate on the program.

### Graduate careers:

- 6 SFFD firefighters
- 4 are currently in the 133rd SFFD Fire Academy
- 4 are currently scheduled for SFFD Chief interviews for invitation
- to the 134<sup>th</sup> SFFD Fire Academy
- 8 are working as full-time EMTs for SFFD
- 5 will be in the next SFFD EMT Academy starting April 1st
- 8 students have returned to college and are taking prerequisites for medical school, nursing, and becoming paramedics.
- 12 students are still working through passing the state test.
- Most graduates are working in the EMT field.
