WIOA Fund Transfer Process




















EDD allocates WIOA funds to **WISF**

WISF allocates WIOA funds to job centers and training providers

OEWD reviews WIOA costs/outcomes & recommends adjustments

WISE considers rec. & OEWD submits fund transfer request to EDD

EDD Regional Advisor determines approval

(4) TRANSFER AUTHORITY.—A local board may transfer, if such a transfer is approved by the Governor, up to and including 100 percent of the funds allocated to the local area under paragraph (2)(A) or (3), and up to and including 100 percent of the funds allocated to the local area under paragraph (2)(B), for a fiscal year between—


(A) adult employment and training activities; and (B) dislocated worker employment and training activities.




WIOA Fund Transfer Rationale
