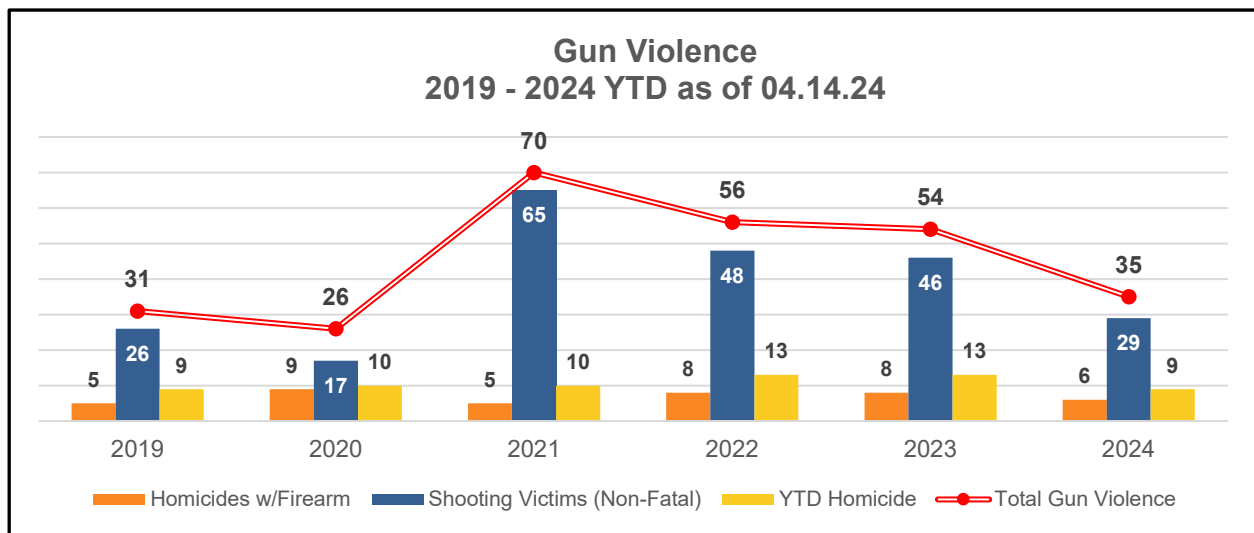

GUN VIOLENCE – DOWN 35% compared to 2023

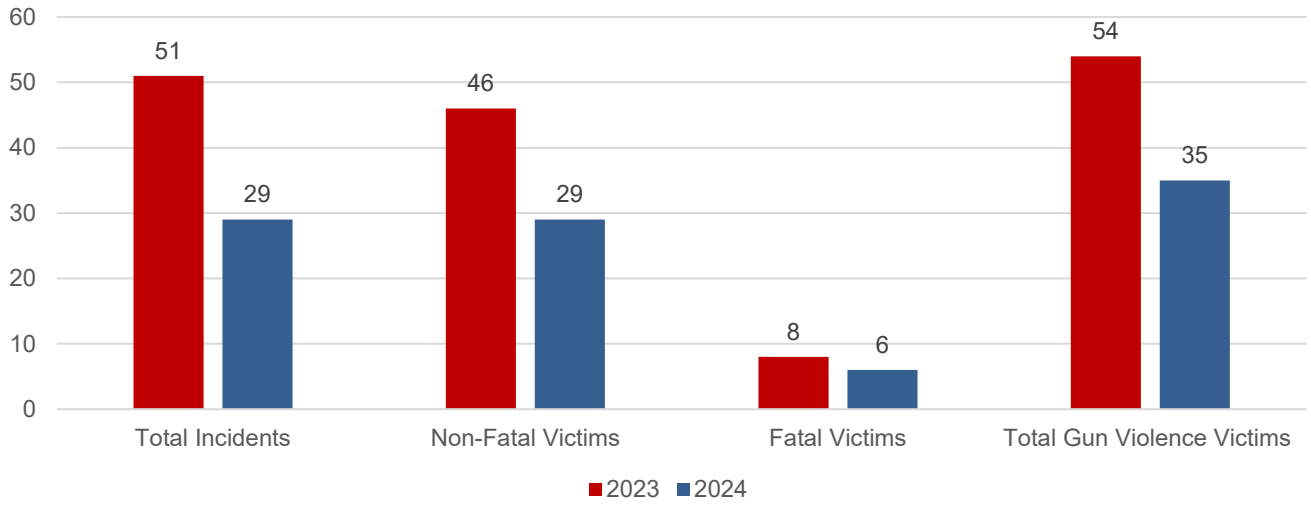
- **There were 4 shooting incidents (fatal/non-fatal) causing injuries to 4 victims this week.**
 - For the year, there are a total of 29 firearm-related incidents resulting in 35 victims
- **There were no homicide incidents for the week ending 04.14.2024**
 - There are 9 homicides YTD with 6 incidents resulting from a firearm.
 - **Overall Clearance Rate: 88% for 2024**



*Total Gun Violence = Non-fatal Shooting Victims + Fatal Shooting Victims

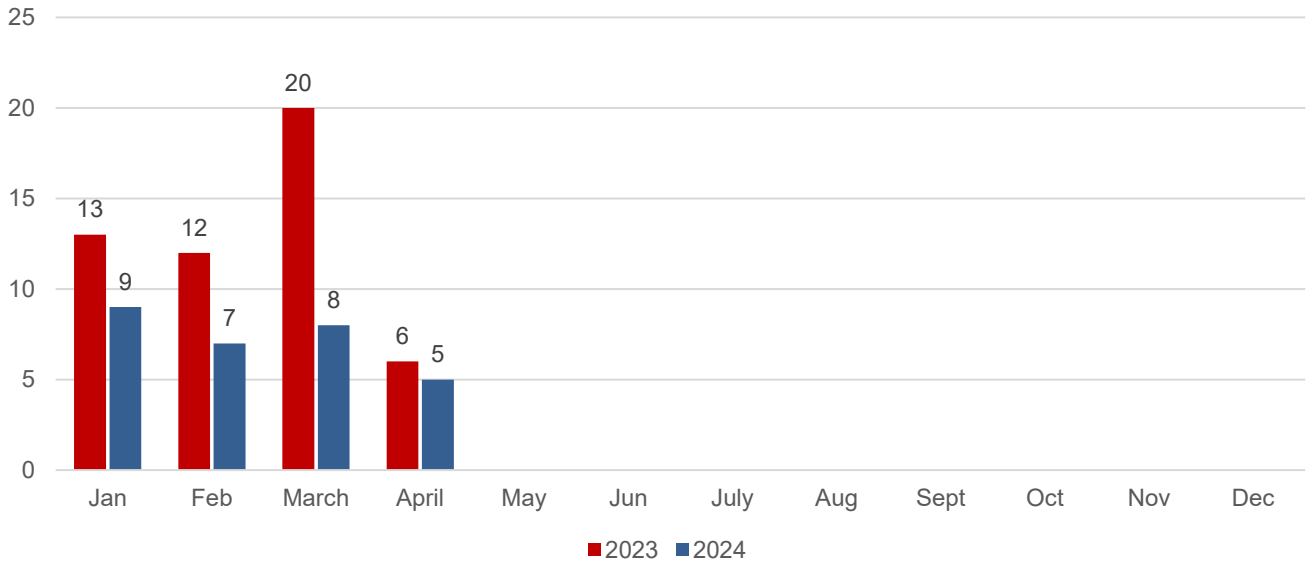

Gun Violence YTD Comparison 2023 vs. 2024

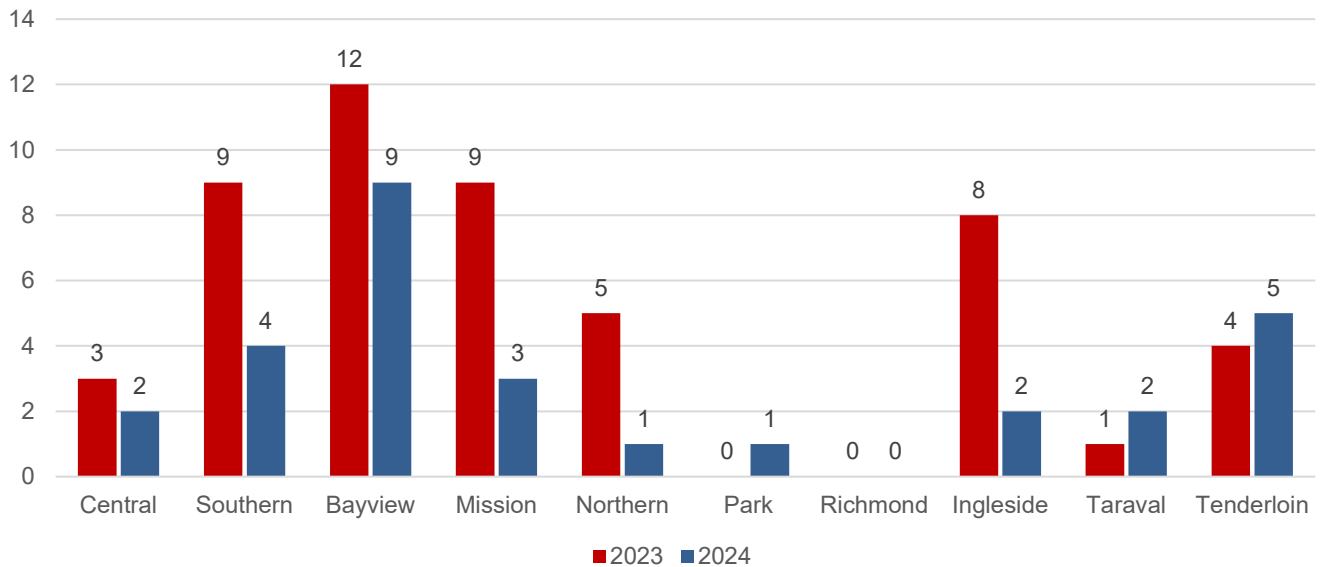

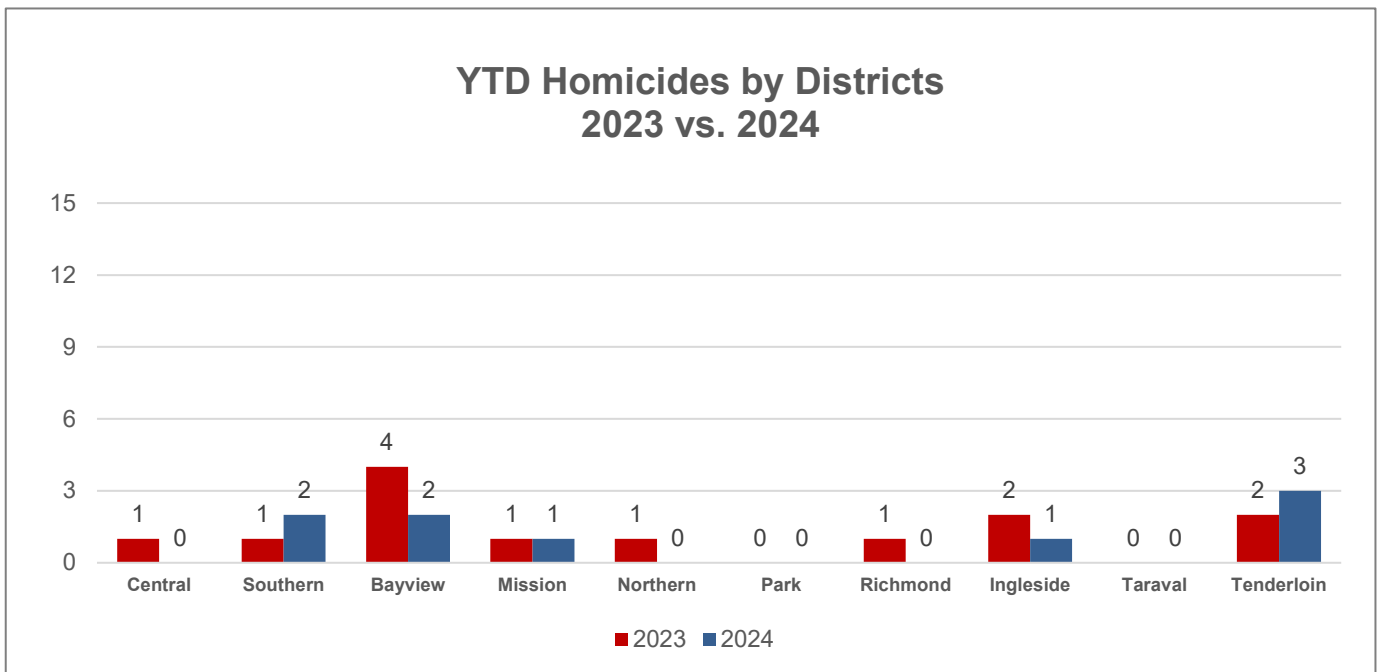
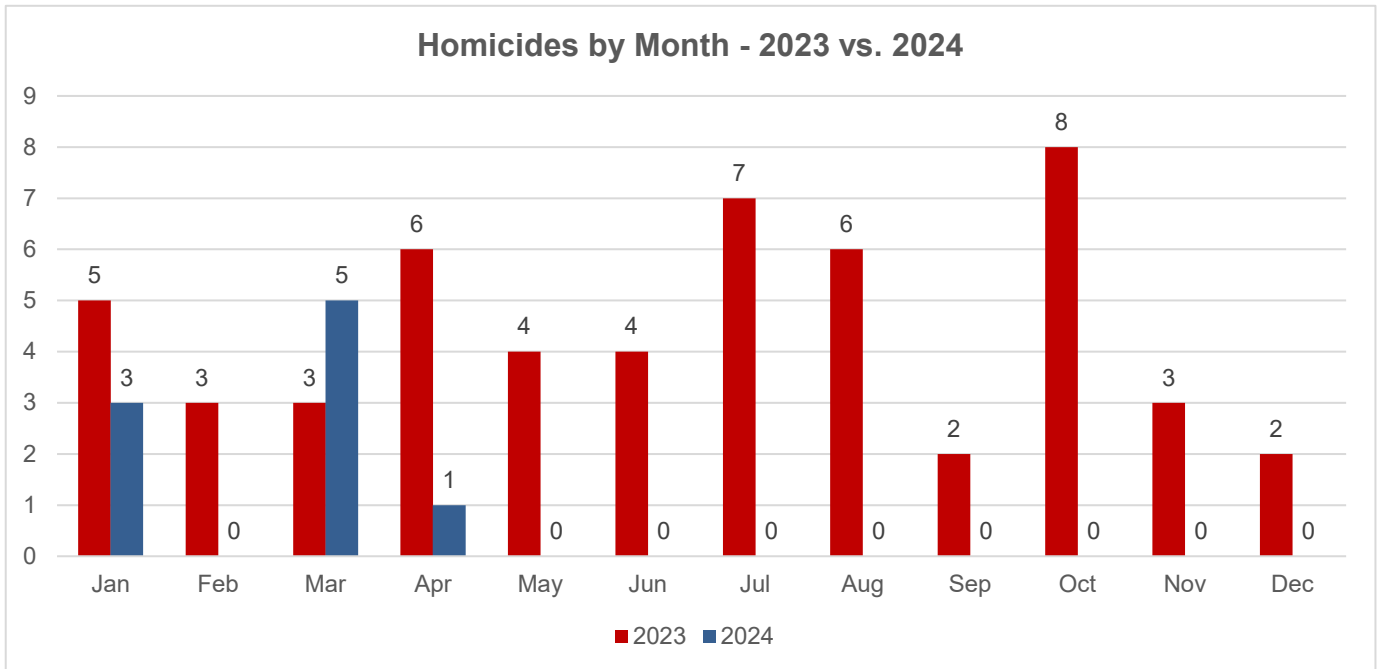
Shootings YTD - By Month - 2023 vs. 2024
