# Highlights For the Week of May 8, 2024

The following report includes the Department of Police Accountability's recent developments since the last Police Commission meeting:

- DPA's Audit Division attended the Association of Local Government Auditors 2024 Conference and hosted two presentations.
- DPA's Operations Division is in the final stage of uploading DPA data to DataSF.
- DPA's Outreach and Legal presented at the SFPD Academy's Promotions Class.

## **Investigation Updates**

Below is an update on DPA's investigations since the last Commission meeting.

- **Cases Opened/Closed**: Our office opened 64 new cases and closed 63 cases since the last Commission meeting. We have opened 23 cases in the past week.
- **Cases Pending**: Our pending cases have remained relatively constant over the last month.
- **Cases Sustained**: Increased from 20 to 28, reflecting a substantial increase in sustained cases since the last commission meeting.
- **Cases Past 270-days**: We reduced our cases above the 270-day deadline by 3.

### **Investigations Over 270-Days/Tolling**

#### The DPA has 25 cases open for more than 270 days. Of those, 22 cases (88%) are "tolled".

Note: Per California Government Code Section 3304, there are several exceptions that "toll," or pause, one-year statute of limitations.

This year, **DPA has conducted an increasing number of resource intensive investigations** involving multiple officers, complex data analysis, and the need to obtain court orders. Examples include:

- Officer involved shooting investigation closures
- Investigations involving juveniles, which require DPA to seek a court order
- Investigations involving stop data collection required by California state law

### **DPA Sustained Cases Pending Final Adjudication**

- There are <u>119 cases</u> sustained by DPA that are pending with the Chief
- There are <u>13 cases</u> pending with the San Francisco Police Commission
