## **Project Description**

The San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency (SFMTA) proposes to implement pedestrian and bicycle safety improvements on Valencia Street, between 15th Street and 23<sup>rd</sup> Street, as part of the Valencia Bikeway Project (project). The project would convert the existing curbside Class II bicycle lanes into a center-running protected bikeway (Class IV) and implement pedestrian safety improvements such as daylighting and advanced limit lines. Valencia Street between 15th Street and 23rd Street is on the High Injury Network. The project supports the citywide Vision Zero initiative to quickly implement safety improvements on the High Injury Network.

## Determination

The City and County of San Francisco decided to carry out or approve the project on April 4, 2023, when the SFMTA Board of Directors approved the project. The project was officially approved on May 5, 2023, when no appeal of the statutory exemption was filed during the 30-day appeal period.
