

DESCRIPTION OF NATURE, PURPOSE AND BENEFICIARIES OF PROJECT: The nature of the Project is to rehabilitate the west and east berths at the San Francisco Ferry Terminal, including replacing the existing hydraulic systems at both berths with a new hydraulic system, dry docking the east ramp to perform steel and paint repairs, and all other related work items as required to complete the project titled *San Francisco Ferry Terminal West and East Berth Ramp Rehabilitation*, as shown on the Contract Drawings.

The purpose of the Project is to rehabilitate and extend the service life of the existing west and east berths.

The beneficiaries of the Project are the Golden Gate Bridge, Highway and Transportation District and the public.


